H. H. H. Page 40 Reference being thereunto had may more fully appear together with all Trees, woods, under-woods commons common water and water courses whatsoever to the said Tract belonging or in any wise appertaining and also the Reversion and Reversions, Remainder and Remainders Tenths and Services of the said premises and of every part thereof and also all the Right Title Interest Claim or demand of him the said Uriah Conner or his heirs the said Tract of Land containing nine hundred & eighty acres and every part and parcel thereof To have & to hold all and singular the Premises above mentioned unto the said Isaac Morgan and his heirs for ever and the said Uriah Conner for himself and his heirs the said Tract with the appertinences thereof against him and his heirs to the said Isaac Morgan his heirs and assigns will warrant and defend by these presents In Witness whereof the said Uriah Conner hath hereunto set his hand the day and date above written.

The following deed of conveyance from Daniel Kelley to William Shipps was Proven before Geo Salmon Esquire by the oath of Elias Earle and Recorded this 30th day of June A 1790

This Indenture made the fifteenth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and ninety and in the fourteenth year of the Independence of the united States of America, between Dan Kelley of Greenville County and State of South Carolina of the one Part, and Wm Shipps of the County and State aforesaid of the other Part Witnesseth that the said Kelley for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty Pounds Sterling to him in hand Paid before the sealing and delivering of these Presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have Granted bargained sold and conveyed and by this Presents doth
