229 The following deed of Conveyance from David McVay to Isaac Wilkens  
was produced in Court November Term 1790 and acknowledged in Open  
Court by the said David McVay and ordered to be Recorded  
Recor'd this 10th day of December 1790.

This indenture made the ninth day of April in the year  
of our one thousand seven hundred and Ninety & in the fourteenth year of  
the Independence of the united States of America between David  
McVay of Greenville County of the one part & Isaac Wilkens of  
the other part Witnesseth that the said David McVay for and in  
consideration of the sum of sixty pounds Sterling to him in  
hand paid by the said Isaac Wilkens at and before the sealing  
& delivering these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknow-  
ledged hath granted bargained sold aliene enfeoffed conveyed &  
confirmed & by these presents doth Grant bargain Sell alien  
enfeoff convey & confirm unto the s<sup>d</sup> Isaac Wilkens his heirs &  
assigns for ever a certain Tract or parcel of Land lying situate in  
the County of Greenville & State of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina District of ninety  
six on the branches of Enoree & Saluda it being part of a Tract or  
parcel of Land Granted to Robert Prince the seventh day of March  
one thousand seven hundred & Eighty eight & sold to the said David  
McVay by s<sup>d</sup> Prince & acknowledged by s<sup>d</sup> Prince in Open Court in  
May 1790 beginning at a pine trees Corner thence S 12 E with his line  
25 chain 50 links to a little branch thence up said branch to a Stake  
& thence along a line made by s<sup>d</sup> McVay and said Wilkens on a ridge  
to an Oak Blaze for that purpose & thence along s<sup>d</sup> line to Jane  
McWentkins line on a Teal Oak on a ridge thence along her line N.  
60 E to a Teal Oak her corner thence with her line N. 30 W 22 Ch to a  
Stake thence N. 60 E 25 Ch to a stake thence S 60 E 15 Ch to a Stake  
Snodders Corner thence with his line S 40 W 4 Ch to a white oak  
thence with his line S 75 E 35 Ch to a Black oak Snodders corner from  
thence to the beginning containing Two hundred and fifty acres be the  
same more or less being part of a Tract or parcel of Land containing  
Four thousand acres dated the 7th day of March 1788 and under the  
hand of the honourable W<sup>m</sup> Moultrie Esq<sup>r</sup> & Great Seal of the State  
for that purpose appointed & duly Recorded in the Secretaries Office
