235 The following title from Thomas Farrar to William Basley was produced in Open Court and proven by the oath of John Gowen and ordered to be Recorded, Recorded this 22nd December 1790

State of South Carolina

This Indenture made the fifteenth day of July one thousand seven hundred and ninety & in the Fifteenth year of American Independance between Thomas Farrar Esq^r Sheriff of a Ninety six district & the State aforesaid of the one part & William Basley of the other part witnesseth Whereas John McElheny was lately seized in fee simple to him & his heirs for ever of & in all that plantation or Tract of land containing Two hundred acres be the same more or less situate lying and being in the district of a Ninety six Greenville County on both sides of the Middle Fork of Tyger River adjoining to lands laid out to Michael Miller on the west and hath such shapes form & Marks as is Represented by a plat hereunto annexed & whereas Robert Carter did in April Term in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & Eighty Four commence an action of Damage in the Court of Common Pleas at Charleston against the s^d John McElheny in which action such proceedings were had in the said Court that the s^d Robert Carter did on the third day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and Eighty Five Obtain Judgment against the s^d John McElheny in the Court aforesaid for the sum of one hundred & fifty pounds Sterling Money for the damage & Cost by him expended in behalf of his s^d suit as in & by the Records of the s^d Court Reference therunto being had may more fully & at large appear in pursuance of which Judgment there issued from the Court afores^d a certain Writ of Fieri Facias Issued by the Honourable Thomas Heywood Esquire one of the associate Judges of the s^d Court at Charleston in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and Eighty eight and in the Twelfth year of American Independance directed to all & singular the Sheriffs of s^d State commanding them & each of them that of the Goods & Chattels houses lands and other hereditaments & Real Estate of the s^d John McElheny they should cause to be levied the sum of one hundred & fifty pounds Sterling Money for which the s^d Robert Carter against the s^d McElheny in the Court aforesaid had lately obtained Judgment as before set forth in Obedience to which writ of Fieri Facias he the s^d Thomas Farrar Sheriff of the s^d a Ninety six district did seize & Take into execution all the aforesaid plantation or Tract of land herein before described & after giving & having give due & Legal notice of exposing the same to sale at public Auction by advertising in the public Gazette & otherwise the s^d Thomas Farrar did on the fifteenth day of March one thousand Seven hundred & ninety for & Towards Satisfaction
