



 -on of Two hundred acres of land be the same more or less together with all & singular the
 Gardens, Ways, Wells, Waters, water-courses, easements, profits, commodities hereditaments
 & appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining to have &
 to hold the said bargained land and premises herein before mentioned be the s^d land more or
 less unto the only proper use and behoof of him the said John Stanford Jun^r his heirs Ex^t.
 Adm^r or assigns for ever & to no other use Intent or purpose whatsoever & he the said Randolph
 Casey & Charity Casey his wife their heirs Ex^t. Adm^r & assigns doth covenant agree to and
 with the s^d John Stanford Jun^r his heirs Ex^t. Adm^r & assigns that they shall at any time & at
 all times hereafter peacefully & quietly Occupy possess & enjoy the said bargained land and
 premises from all former bargains sales & mortgages Judgments Executions Dowers Right
 & Title of dowers and all Incumbrances whatsoever & that he the said Randolph Casey and
 Charity Casey his wife their heirs Ex^t. Adm^r & assigns shall & will warrant & for ever defend
 the said plantation or tract of Land or Two hundred Acres be the same more or less unto him
 the said John Stanford Jun^r his heirs Ex^t. Adm^r or assigns, from any person or persons hav-
 -ing any lawful Right title property Interest claim or demand to the s^d land and premises

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The following deed of conveyance from Levi Casey & Mary his wife to John Stan-
 -ford Jun^r was proven before Robert Nelson Esq^r produced in open Court and ordered
 to be Recorded which was done this 5th day of March A 1791 ~

This Indenture made the twentieth of June in the year of our Lord one
 thousand seven hundred & ninety & in the fourteenth year of the Independence of
 the united states of America between Levi Casey & Mary Casey his wife of the
 County of Greenville & state of S^c Carolina Planter of the one part & John Stanford
 Jun^r of the County & state aforesaid Planter of the other Part Witnesseth that
 whereas in & by a certain Grant bearing date the fifth day of February one thousand
 seven hundred & eighty seven under the hand of William Moultrie Esq^r Governor
 & commander in Chief in & over the state aforesaid having the Great seal of the
 state afores^d therunto affixed did Give & Grant unto the s^d Levi Casey & Tract
