This Indenture made this 19th day of February one thousand seven hundred and ninety one & in the fifteenth year of the Independence of the United States of America between Martin Gollatin of Greenville County of the state of South Carolina of the one part, and Bryan Ward Howlin of the County and State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the s^t Martin Gollatin for & in consideration of the sum of Two pounds seven shilling currante Money of S^t Carolina to him in hand Paid by the s^t Bryan Ward Howlin the receipt whereof is hereby Acknowledged hath Given Granted Bargained & sold alined and confirmed and by these presents do Give Grant Bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said Bryan Ward Howlin his heirs and assigns for ever one certain Tract or parcel of land containing Twenty Acres be the same more or less lying & being in Greenville County and on a branch of Reedy River and bounded as followeth to wit; beginning at a Lightwood Stake in s^t Howlin's line thence
