The following deed of conveyance from George Haine & Marget Haine to Duncan McWilkins was proven in court by the oath of Vincent Anson & ordered to be Recorded, which was done this 24th day of March 1791

This Indenture made the fourteenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety one and in the fourteenth year of the Independance of the united States of America between George Haine and Marget his wife Greenville County in the state of S^c. Carolina of one part & Duncan McWilkins of the County & State afores^d. of the other part, Witnesseth that whereas and by a certain Grant bearing date the fifth day of December one thousand seven hundred and eighty six under the hand of William Moultrie Esq^r Governor & commander in chief & over the state afores^d. having the Great seal of the s^t. State thereunto affixed did give & Grant unto the s^r. Thomas Beaves a Tract of land containing Two hundred & Forty acres situate in Greenville County on both sides of S^c. Tiger River Bounding Ely^s. Puttets land having such forms & marks as Represented by a plat to the said annexed which Plat & Grant was duly Recorded in Secretary's Office of said State Reference therunto had may appear & Now this Indenture witnesseth that the s^r. George Haine for & in consideration of Forty pounds s^c. Money to him in hand well and Truly paid by the s^r. McWilkins before the sealing & delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have Granted bargained sold aliened conveyed & confirmed & by these presents doth Grant bargain sell alien convey & confirm unto the said Duncan McWilkins now in his
