

The following deed of conveyance from Absalom Barney and Sarah his wife to Joseph King was pro-  
-ved in Open Court May Term 1791 and Ordered to be  
Recorded which was done this 18<sup>th</sup> day of May 1791

This Indenture made the eighteenth day of  
February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven  
hundred and ninety one and in the fifteenth year of the  
Independence of the united States of America between  
Absalom Barney of Greenville County and State of S.<sup>c</sup>  
Carolina of the one part and Joseph King of the Coun-  
-ty and State aforesaid of the other Part Witnesseth that  
The s.<sup>c</sup> Absalom Barney for and in consideration of the sum  
of Forty Pounds Sterling to him in hand well and Truly  
paid, the s.<sup>c</sup> Absalom Barney hath bargained and sold and  
by these presents doth bargain and sell make over and convey  
unto the s.<sup>c</sup> Joseph King his heirs and assigns a certain  
Tract or parcel of Land containing forty acres more or  
less being part of a Tract Originally Granted unto the said  
Absalom Barney and bearing date 1784 one thousand seven  
hundred and eighty four lying and being on both sides of Enoree River  
S.<sup>c</sup> Tract of Forty acres of Land Lying as follows Beginning at  
the north corner of Absalom Barneys Running thence to the  
River on the upper line from thence down the River to the  
first branch below the upper line thence up the branch to  
the line running from thence to the beginning corner which  
is the north corner which s.<sup>c</sup> forty acres of Land more or less  
is now duly Granted Released and Remitted unto the s.<sup>c</sup> Joseph  
King with all Gardens houses Appurtenances thereunto be-  
-longing Together with the Rents services thereof to have and  
to hold the s.<sup>c</sup> Tract or parcel of Land and premises above  
mentioned with the Appurtenances thereto belonging  
unto the said Joseph King, his heirs and assigns for ever to  
the only proper use and behoof of him the s.<sup>c</sup> Joseph King his  
heirs and assigns for ever and the s.<sup>c</sup> Absalom Barney for  
himself his heirs Exor.<sup>s</sup> & Adm.<sup>r</sup>s doth covenant to & with the  
s.<sup>c</sup> Joseph King his heirs Exor.<sup>s</sup> Adm.<sup>r</sup>s that the s.<sup>c</sup> Absalom  
Barney at and before the signing & delivering of these presents  
is & stands lawfully bound in the above demised premises
