


6 The following Bill of Sale from Thomas Lewis to Vincent Davis was proven before John & Alexander Esq^r by the oath of Gershom Kelley and Ordered to be Recorded which was done this 16th day of July 1791

Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Lewis of the County of Greenville and state of south Carolina for and in Consideration of the sum of one hundred and fourteen Pounds paid by Vincent Davis of the County and State aforesaid hath bargained and sold unto the said Vincent Davis his heirs and assigns for ever the three following Negroes (now in his possession) To wit one Negroe Man named Peter; one named Tom. one Woman named Esther to have and to hold the said Negroes above mentioned unto the said Vincent Davis his heirs & assigns for ever & do hereby agree for myself my heirs & assigns and administrators with the said Vincent Davis his heirs and assigns the said Negroes to warrant and for ever defend by these presents. Witness my hand and seal this sixth day of May 1791
