7 The Following Deed of Conveyance from John Thomas to Vincent Davis was proven before John Alexander Esquire by the Oath of Gershom Kelley, & produced in Open Court July Term 1791 and Ordered to be Recorded which was done this 16<sup>th</sup> day of July 1791

This Indenture made the day of May one thousand seven hundred and ninety one between John Thomas of the County of Greenville and state of South Carolina of the one part and Vincent Davis of the County and state aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred Pounds Sterling in hand paid by the said Vincent Davis the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said John Thomas hath Granted bargained and sold aliene Conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth Grant Bargain and sell alien Convey and Confirm unto the said Vincent Davis his heirs and assigns for ever all that plantation or Tract of Land Containing one hundred and sixty acres beginning at a Red oak st Running thence N. 61° E. 38 chain 42 links to a pine stake st thence S. 29° E. 41 Chain 24 links to a Red Oak sapling st thence S. 60 W. 37 Ch. 34 Links to a pine stake Thence N. 32 W. 41 Chains 26 links to the beginning being Part of a Tract of 640 Acres of Land Originally Granted to Thomas Lewis on the sixteenth day of July 1781 Recorded in the Secretarys Office in Grant Book 5<sup>th</sup> Page 65 and Reference being thereunto had may more fully appear: and from said Thomas Lewis conveyed to said John Thomas by Deed bearing date the sixth day of March seven & ninety situate in the County aforesaid on Horse Creek of Needy River, Together with all and singular the Houses Trees, woods, under-woods, waters and water Courses profits Commodities Advantages hereditaments ways and
