 Thomas Bell was proven before Robert M^offe Esq^r by the
 oath of George Sanders produced in Open Court and
 Ordered to be recorded which was done this 1st August 1791
 This Indenture made this Eighteenth day of June and
 in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and
 Ninety one and in the fifteenth year of the Independence
 of the united states of America between George Ross of
 the state of S^c. Carolina Greenville County of the one
 part, & Thomas Bell of the same state and County of
 the other part Witnesseth that the said George Ross for &
 in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds sterling
 Money to him in hand well and Truly paid by the said
 Thomas Bell at or before the sealing and delivery of
 these presents the Receipt whereof the said George Ross
