

the oath of Robert Maxwell Esq^r and Ordered to be recorded
which was done this 10th day of August 1791

This Indenture made the second day of April
one thousand seven hundred and ninety one between
John Ware of the state of S. Carolina of the one part &
Reuben Tarrant of the same place of the other part Wit-
nesseth that the said John Ware for & in consideration
of one hundred pounds sterling current Money of S.
Carolina to him in hand paid at and before the sealing &
delivery of these presents by the s^d. Reuben Tarrant the
Receipt whereof the said John Ware doth hereby acknow-
ledge and thereof & of and from every part and parcel
whereof do acquit and discharge the said Reuben Tarrant
his heirs and assigns for divers other Causes & considerations
