To Joseph Baur was proven before James Harrison
Esq^r by the Oath of James Peck and Recited this 17th
day of November 1791.

This Indenture made this
Twenty fourth day of May Anno Domini one thousand
seven hundred and Eighty Eight & in the Twelfth year of
American Independency Between Richard Collins of
Spartanburgh and State of S^c Carolina of the one part
and Joseph Baur of Greenville County and State afores^d
of the other part Witnesseth that whereas in and by the
letters patent bearing date the fifth day of March and in
the year one thousand seven hundred & Eighty seven under
the Hand of his Excellency Thomas Pinckney Captain Gene-
ral Governour and commander in chief in and over the state
of S^c Carolina did give and Grant unto Richard Collins a
Tract of land containing four hundred & Sixty nine acres
lying and being in the District of ninety six on both sides
of Gilders Creek including the place known by the name
of the three forks of said Creek beginning at a post oak
Running North 80^o W 67 To a Chestnut & post oak 3+ thence
North 10^o E 70 To a Stake 3+ thence S 80^o E 67 To a stake 3+
thence South 10^o W 70 crossing the Creek to the Beginning
bounded on all sides by vacant land which may appear
by a plat to the S^d letters patent annexed for or in the
State of S^c Carolina. Now This Indenture Wit-
