

The following Deed of Conveyance from John Childers
to Charles Bruce being proven before John Thomas
Jun^r Esq^r was produced in Open Court February Term
1792 and Ordered to be Recorded which was done this
22nd day of February 1792.

This Indenture made the thirtieth day
of September in the year of our Lord one thousand
seven hundred and ninety one Between John Childers
of Greenville County in the State of S^c Carolina
Halter of the one part, and Charles Bruce of the Coun-
ty & State aforesaid Carpenter of the other part Wit-
nesseth that the said John Childers for and in
consideration of the sum of twenty pounds Sterling
Money to him in hand well & Truly paid by the said
Charles Bruce the receipt whereof the said John Child-
ers doth hereby acknowledge and for which the said
John Childers hath granted Bargain sold Release
Released conveyed and Confirmed and by these presents
doth Grant Bargain sell Release Convey and
confirm unto the said Charles Bruce his heirs and
assigns all that plantation Tract or parcel of land
containing one hundred acres more or less, in his
Actual possession now being and including the planta-
tion ~~on~~ which the said Childers now lives, lying
and being in the County and State aforesaid on a
Branch of the S^c Fork of Tyger River known by the
name of Childers's Beaver Dam Beginning on a Maple
on the said Beaver dam thence N^o 5 E 30 Ch^o to the
Wagon Road leading from Col^o Thomas's to John
Nichol's thence along said Road to Jeremiah Dutton's
upper or back line, thence S^o 5 W^o 915 Ch^o 50 Ch^o to
Beaver dam Creek aforesaid, thence down the
