The following Deed of Conveyance from Nicholas Darnall to John Slater being proven before Ashmead Esq^r was produced in Open Court February Term 1792 and Ordered to be Recorded which was done this 24th day of February 1792

This Indenture made the ninth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety one in the sixteenth year of the Liberty & Independance of the united States of America Between Nicholas Darnall of Pendleton County State of S^c. Carolina of the one part and
