 hath such shape & form as a plat thereof to the Original  
 Grant annexed represents, Reference being had  
 thereto, will more fully appear which plantation  
 or Tract of land was granted to Wadsworth & Turpin  
 the first day of January 1737 by his Excellency  
 William Moultrie Esquire, the aforesaid Tract of  
 one hundred acres of land doth include the plantation  
 whereon the said William Chandler now lives being
