Wadsworth & William Turpin for and in consideration  
of the sum of Twenty pounds Current Money of the  
state aforesaid unto them in hand well & truly paid  
by the s<sup>d</sup> William Whorton at and before the sealing  
and delivery hereof the receipt whereof they doth  
herby acknowledge and thereof & of every part thereof  
do for ever Constitute acquit & discharge the said  
William Whorton his heirs & Adm<sup>rs</sup> by these  
presents have Granted bargained sold, aliened Enfe-  
offed Released and confirmed and by these presents  
do Grant bargain sell alien enfeoff Release and  
confirm unto the said William Whorton his heirs &  
assigns a certain Tract or parcel of land containing  
three hundred acres lying & being in Greenville County
