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The following deed of conveyance from James Bradley to Carter Tarrant was proven in open Court & May term 1792 by the oath of Robert Maxwell Esq^r and ordered to be Recorded which was done this 25th day of July 1792.

This Indenture made this fourteenth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety two and in the sixteenth year of American Independence between James Bradley of the one part, and Carter Tarrant of the other part Witnesseth that the said James Bradley for and in consideration of the sum of sixty pounds Sterling Money to him in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the said Carter Tarrant the receipt thereof by the S^r James Bradley is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold aliened released and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release and confirm unto the said Carter Tarrant his heirs and assigns for ever one hundred acres of land situate in Greenville County on the Golden Grove Creek waters of Saluda river all of which lies west of the Grove Creek on the east ^{beginning} being part of ~~two~~ ^{one} hundred acres of land more or less to the Meander of the said Grove Creek on the east being part of Two hundred acres of land granted to S^r James Bradley on the fifteenth day of October 1754 by Governor Quarles & bounded by Francis Gottier on the S. E. and all other sides Variant land reference being had to the plat annexed to the Original Grant will more fully appear Together with all singular the trees way

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
