& reversion Remainder & Remainders with Issues & Profits
thereof To have & to hold the said parcel or Tract of Land &
premises hereby Bargained & sold & every of their appurtenance
-es unto the said William Payne his heirs & assigns to his & their
only proper use & behoof absolutely for ever & lastly the
