

The following Deed of Conveyance from Francis Bremar to James Cooper being proven before John Alexander Esq^r by the Oath of Gershom Kelley was presented in Open Court October Term 1792 and ordered to be recorded, which was done this 3^d January 1793 This Indenture made this Twentieth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety and between Francis Bremar of the City of Charleston Esq^r of the one part; and James Cooper of Greenville County and Washington District planter of the other part Witnesseth that the said Francis Bremar for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen pounds lawful Sterling Money to him the said Francis in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have Granted bargained sold aliened Release & confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien Release & confirm unto the said James Cooper his heirs & assigns for ever all that tract or parcel of land Originally surveyed for King Solomon Chandler and Granted to Francis Bremar on the 4th day of December 1786 Situate lying & being in the aforesaid County of Greenville and on the North West side of Rocky Creek waters of Uedy River beginning on a white Oak on a Creek from thence N 50° 31' 62" to a hycory corner from thence E 40° 31' 62" to a pine corner thence S 50° 31' 62" a white oak Corner on Uedy River from thence up said River & Creek to the beginning containing one hundred acres be the same more or less as by a plat to the Original Grant will appear Bounded at the Time of Survey on all sides by Vacant Land, but now bounded on the East & North E by lands Originally surveyed for Richard Langston on the west & North West by land Granted to Mianor Hudson Southward Rocky Creek & Uedy River Together with all and singular the Trees waters hereditaments rights members and appurtenances whatsoever to the said Tract of land Premises hereby bargained & sold belonging or in any wise appertaining & the reversion and reversions, Remainders & Remainders Tenths Issues & profits thereof to have & to hold the s^d parcel or Tract of land & Premises hereby bargained & sold & their and every of their appurtenances unto the said James Cooper his heirs & assigns to his and their only proper use & behoof absolutely and forever and lastly the said Francis Bremar for himself and heirs the said Tract of land as above described unto the s^d James
