

The following Deed of Conveyance from George Russell  
to William Lane being proven before Robert C. Wase Esq.  
by the Oath of Thomas Bell was presented in Open Court  
October Term 1792 & ordered to be recorded, done the 3<sup>rd</sup> Juny 1793  
This Indenture made this Twentieth day of February  
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and  
ninety two & in the sixteenth year of American Independence  
between George Russell of the County of Greenville & State  
of S. Carolina of the one part & William Lane of the said  
County & State of the other part, whereas by a certain  
Grant bearing date the third day of May Anno Domini  
one thousand seven hundred & ninety from under the  
hand of his Excellency Charles Pinckney Esq. Governor  
and commander in chief in & over the S. State having  
the great seal of the State thereunto affixed being for that  
purpose appointed did give and Grant unto George Russell  
a plantation or Tract of Land containing Two hundred  
& seventeen acres situate lying in County aforesaid lying  
on Kemps Branch & branch of the Enoree & hath such  
fences & marks bettings & Boundings as appears by plat  
thereunto annexed which said plat & Grant being duly  
Recorded in the Secretarys Office Grant Book B. N. 5  
Page 276 reference therewnto being had may more fully
