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2<sup>o</sup> The following Deed of Conveyance from John Mallin to Benjamin Merritt being proven before Parker Tarant Esq<sup>r</sup> was presented in Open Court & May Term 1793 and Ordered to be Recorded which was done this 23<sup>rd</sup> May 1793  
This Indenture made this fifth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred Ninety Three Between John Mallin of the one part, & Benjamin Merritt of the other part both of the state of South Carolina and Greenville County situate that the said John Mallin and Elisabeth his wife for and in consideration of seven pounds ten shillings Sterling Money to him paid in hand by said Benjamin Merritt at or before the sealing of these presents the receipt whereof he doth fully acknowledge he the said John Mallin & Elisabeth his wife hath given granted bargained sold, and by these presents doth give grant bargain & sell alien & release convey & confirm unto the said Benjamin Merritt and to his heirs & assigns for ever a certain Tract, parcel or body of Land situated lying & being in the state & County aforesaid on a branch of Saluda called Chebarow and in ninety six distinct buttings being & bounding by a line running S. E. by a tract of land formerly Granted to said John Mallin & since deeded by him to said Benjamin Merritt its courses as follows beginning at a Hickory running N. 70 to a Hickory 13 to a coveer wood thence S. 20 E. 30.00 to a cherry Tree, thence S. 65 to a Laurel, thence 20 to a stake N. 80 to a Maple 11 13 to a Beech, thence N. 10 E. 31.00 to the beginning line containing by Estimation 66 Acres More or less granted to the said John Mallin by letters patent under the great seal of S. Carolina bearing date 15<sup>th</sup> day of
