214 The following deed of Conveyance from James Garrison to Archibald Taylor being proven before John Thomas Esq. Esquire was presented in Court May Term 1798 & ordered to be Recorded, which was done this 25th May 1798
 This Indenture made the Twentieth day of March in the year of our said one thousand seven hundred and ninety two between James Garrison of Carolina Greenville County of the one part and Archibald Taylor of Greenville County & State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said James Garrison for & in consideration of the sum of seventy pounds Sterling Money to him the said James Garrison in hand well & truly paid by the said Archibald Taylor the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said James Garrison hath granted bargained sold aliened released conveyed and confirmed, & by these presents doth grant bargain sell, alien release convey & confirm unto the said Archibald Taylor his heirs & assigns for ever a Tract of land containing one hundred & twenty eight Acres, that was granted to Thomas Goeg under the hand of Thomas Pinckney Esquire Governor having the great seal of the S. State herunto attested
