This Indenture made the second day of January in the
 year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety
 three between William Pearson of the State of South Caro-
 lina & County of Greenville of the one part, & Noble
 Johnson of the State & County aforesaid of the other part
 Witnesseth that the said William Pearson for & in consi-
 deration of the sum of forty pounds Sterling Money
 to him the said William Pearson in hand well & truly
 paid by the Noble Johnson the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged; the said William Pearson
 hath granted bargained sold, aliened released conveyed
 & confirmed: & by these presents doth grant bargain
 sell alien release convey & confirm unto the said
 Noble Johnson his heirs & Adm^r. & assigns for ever
 in his actual possession now a certain Tract or parcel
 of land containing by Estimation one hundred acres of
 land more or less situate lying & being in the afores^d County
