 ear mark, one Bindle of Heifer white face no ear mark, three
 year olds, one powder dish & three plates, one Iron pot & one
 shining wheel, all which goods & chattels above mentioned
 I the said William Terry do hereby warrant and defend to
 the said Prussilla Terry from the best right title claim
 or claims of any person or persons whatsoever it being
 for and in consideration of the sum of Twelve pounds
 in hand paid by her In witness whereof I have hereunto
