Creechville County } I know all persons whom it may concern that I Sarama Brown for the consideration of the sum of Fifty pounds Lawful money to me in hand paid by George Harrison whereof I do hereby acknowledge I have bargained sold delivered & certain Black Horse six years old with aster in his forehead & grey in the right forefoot about fourteen hands & better high & a sorrel Horse about 2 years old with his hind feet white & a small blaze down his face & a feather bed, & a little wheel the said Sarama Brown doth warrant and defend the said above Horses & Bed & Wheel from all person or persons whom it may concern to lay any claim or title to the above property given under my hand & seal this 24th day of April 1793.
