The following Deed of Conveyance from James Harrison to Noah-
 canor Hudson being proven before John Alexander Esq^r was
 presented and recorded this 15th day of June 1798
 This Indenture made this tenth day of September one thou-
 sand seven hundred and ninety two between James Harrison of
 South Carolina and Granville County of the one part, and Noah-
 canor Hudson of the said State & County of the other part Witness-
 eth that the said James Harrison for & in consideration of
 the sum of five pounds lawful Sterling money to him in
 hand well & truly paid at & before the sealing & delivery of these
 presents the receipt thereof is hereby fully acknowledged hath
 given, granted, bargained, sold, aliened, released & confirmed, & by
 these presents, doth give, grant, bargain, sell, alien, release & confirm
 unto him the said Noahcanor Hudson his heir and assigns for
 ever all that part of a certain Tract of land lying & being in Gran-
 ville County and on Nuddy river Originally granted unto James
