South Carolina This Indenture made the Twenty
first Day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand seven
hundred and ninety Two Between Thomas Madsworth & William
Turpin on the one part and Enoch Benson on the other part all
of the state aforesaid for & in consideration of the sum of Ten
pounds current money unto them well & Truly paid by the said
Enoch Benson at and before the sealing and delivery hereof the
receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge and every part
thereof do for ever acquit and discharge the said Enoch Benson
his heirs &c^t Adm^r by these presents have bargained sold
& released and by these presents do bargain sell & release all our
right title or claim unto the said Enoch Benson his heirs & assigns
of in or to all that plantation or Tract of land containing Two
hundred & Twenty Two acres more or less situate on the waters of
Enoche above the Antient boundary line surveyed by James
Seaborn 26th April 1785 for Will^m Turnbrough and granted to
Augustus Merrick on the 5th February 1787 by his Excellency
Gen^l Moultrie Governor and commander in Chief in and over the
State aforesaid and by him Granted sold to Madsworth & Turpin
in March 1787 Bounded Eastwardly by Savages land on all other
sides on vacant land at the time of the Original Survey &
hath such form & shape as a plat thereof to the Original
Grant annexed represents reference being thereunto had will
more fully appear Together with all the rights members liberties
priviledges & appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging &
the recessions & remainders rents Issues & profits thereof also
all the Estate right Title Interest use or possession claim or
demand of them or either of them the said Madsworth Turpin
in Law Equity or otherwise howsoever of into or out of all &
singular the premises from the Claim of any other person
