This Indenture made this 17th day of December in the
 year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety one
 and in the fifteenth year of the Independence of the United
 States of America Between William Russell of the State of
 South Carolina & County of Greenville of the one part
 and James Taylor of the same State and County of the other
 part Witnesseth that the said William Russell for and in con-
 sideration of the sum of Twenty four pounds Sterling
