

The following Deed of Conveyance from John Conner to Moses
 Kemp being proven before John Thomas Just. Esquire was pre-
 sented in Court May Term 1798 and Ordered to be Recorded
 which was done this 15th day of June 1798.

This Indenture made the tenth day of November in the year
 of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety two between
 John Conner of the State of Georgia of the one part and Moses
 Kemp of the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina
 of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Conner for &
 in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds good and
 lawful Money of the State of South Carolina to him in hand
 well and truly paid at and before the sealing & Delivery hereof
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said John
 Conner, he the said John Conner hath Granted bargained
 sold aliened and confirmed, and by these presents doth he & his
 Grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said Moses
 Kemp his heirs and assigns for ever a certain Tract or parcel of
 Land containing six hundred and sixteen acres situate in Green-
 ville County in the State aforesaid on the Branches of Rocky
 Creek of Enoree River, bounding North East on lands unknown
 on all other sides by vacant land which said Tract of six hundred
 and sixteen acres of Land was granted to the said John Conner by
 a certain Grant bearing Date the seventh day of July in the year
 of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Eighty Eight
