The following Deed of Conveyance from Samuel French to Joseph
 French was proven before George Salmon Esq^r by the Oath of Sam-
 uel Earle and Recorded this 26th day of July 1793

This Indenture made the sixteenth day of August in the year
 of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety Two Between
 Samuel French of Greenville County State of South Carolina
 of the one part and Joseph French of the same place of the other part
 Witnesseth that the said Samuel French for & in consideration of
 the sum of five Shillings Sterling Money to him the said Samuel
 French in hand well and truly paid by the said Joseph French the
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said Samuel French
 hath granted bargained, sold, aliened, released, conveyed & confirmed, & by
 these presents doth grant, bargain, sell, alien, release convey and
 confirm unto the said Joseph French his heirs and assigns for ever
