

The following Deed of Conveyance from Atte Meeks to Joseph Waldrope being proven before Sartin Tarrant Esq^r by the oath of Samuel Roberts was Recorded 9th Sep^r 1793 This Indenture made this 24th day of August one thousand seven hundred and ninety three between Atte Meeks of the State of South Carolina and Greenville County of the one part, and Joseph Waldrope of the S^t State & County of the other part: Witnesseth that the S^t Atte Meeks for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty four pounds Sterling Money to him in hand paid at and before the sealing & delivery of these presents by the said Joseph Waldrope the Receipt thereof is hereby fully acknowledged have granted bargain sold aliened and confirmed, and by these presents do Grant bargain sell Release and confirm unto him the said Joseph Waldrope his heirs and assigns for ever all that part of a certain Tract of Land Originally Granted unto the said Atte Meeks and signed by his Excellency William Moultrie on the seventeenth day of August one thousand seven hundred & Eighty six four hundred & seventy Acres and lying & being in the S^t County of Greenville on the branches of Mountain Creek the waters of Saluda River, all that part of the said Tract of Land beginning near a small Road on a post Oak Corner the Original Corner from thence S. 40° thirty three chains to a Stake on the Original line from thence S E 40° Twenty seven Chain to a Stake Corner, from thence N E 58° forty Eight Chains & fifty links to a Flying corner, from thence N 40° Twenty three chains & Eighty Two links to a Stake Corner on an old line, from thence N 52° fifteen Chains & fifty links to a post oak Corner and old Mark N 45° four Chain to the beginning a post oak Containing one hundred & Twenty five acres or the same more or less, Including part of Two Surveys Originally Granted to the said Atte Meeks and now in actual possession of him the said Joseph Waldrope Together
