The following Deed of Conveyance from George Gough to William Whaley being proven before John Thoman Esq. by the oath of John Edington was Recorded this 19<sup>th</sup> Sept 1793.

This Indenture made the thirty first day of December and in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety two Between George Gough of Granville County and State of South Carolina School Master of the one part, and William Whaley of the County aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth that the said George Gough for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen pounds Sterling Money to him the said George Gough in hand well and truly paid by the said William Whaley the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said George Gough hath Granted bargained sold aliened released conveyed confirmed and by these presents both Grant bargain sell alien release convey and confirm unto the said William Whaley his heirs and assigns for ever in his actual possession now being a certain Tract or parcel of Land containing by Estimation Seventy four or there abouts more or less Situate lying and being in the County aforesaid on the Ridge Between Upper River and Childers Beavers dam Creek of said River Running as followeth Beginning on a post Oak on Woods or Ray line thence S 45 W to the waggon Road leading from John Nicks to Col. Thomax's thence along said Waggon Road to a Conditional line to run between said John Childers and Robert Childers, thence along said Conditional line to Woods line, thence along said Woods line to the beginning being part of a Tract of two hundred and thirty three acres Land Granted to Obudiah Cooper the fifth day of February one thousand seven hundred & Eighty seven together with all and singular the Houses Gardens Orchards woods Trees waters profits advantages hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining and also the
