394 The following Deed of Conveyance from John Jones to Samuel Earle being proven before George Salmon Esq. by the oath of Moses Evans was presented & Recorded this 18th Dec. 1793
This Indenture made the twenty fifth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety three and in the seventeenth year of the Independance of the united States of America between John Jones of the County of Greenville State of South Carolina of the one part, Samuel Earle of the County & State aforesaid of the other part It is made etc that the said John Jones for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds Sterling to him in hand paid before the sealing and delivering of these presents the Receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold & conveyed by these presents do confirm unto the said Samuel Earle his heirs & assigns for ever all that tract or plantation of land lying & being on the dividing Ridge between the N. & S. Forks of Saluda Rivers Beginning at a stake on the said Samuel Earle's land thence N. 79th to Fosters land, thence with Fosters line to a Black Sack & thence N. 75th to a Chesnut & thence N. 50 E to a stake & thence S 7 E to a post oak & thence N. 50 E to a white oak & thence S 62 E to a stake & on M. M. Woods land thence on the said Woods line to the beginning containing two hundred acres be the same more or less being part of two tracts one of which was granted by his Excellency William Moultrie in the year one thousand seven hundred and Eighty five in June the other by his Excellency Charles Pinckney in the year one thousand seven hundred and Eighty nine in April Together with all profits and Benefits and, was conveyed to me from Daniel Kelly the twelfth day of May one thousand seven hundred and Ninety and in fourteenth year of the Independance of the united States of America to the only use & behoof of
