

The following due of Conveyance from George Salmon to ^{James Wood} Richard Winn Wood & William Wood being proven before several ^{Jurors} & the Ex^{rs} by the oath of William Armstrong, was presented and recorded this 20th Day of Dec^r 1798

This Indenture made the twenty second day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety three between George Salmon of Greenville County State of South Carolina of the one part, and James Wood, Richard Winn Wood & William Wood Jun^r and Joint Tenants of Spartanburg County State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said George Salmon for consideration of five shillings Sterling Money to him in hand paid the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said George Salmon hath granted bargained sold aliened Enfeoffed conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff convey confirm unto the said James Wood Richard Winn Wood & William Wood Jun^r all that plantation or tract of land containing three hundred acres situate lying being in Greenville County on Both sides of Beaver dam Creek of Enore Granted to Elisabeth Young by a Grant bearing date the twenty first day of January one thousand seven hundred & Eighty four bounded on all sides by Vacant land at the time of the Original Survey being made and Runs as followeth that is to say beginning on a post oak running thence South twenty seven degrees East sixty chains to a Red oak, thence South Sixty three degrees West fifty chains to a Hickory, thence North Twenty seven degrees West sixty chains to a Red oak, thence to the Beginning Together with all and singular the woods Trees, tithes common, advantages hereditaments, ways waters and appurtenances whatsoever therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining and also the Reversion and Reversions, Remainder and Remainders Rents & Services of the said premises and every part thereof, & all the Estate right Title Interest or demand whatsoever of him the said George Salmon of in & to the same to have and to hold the said tract of land and all and singular the premises above mentioned & every part thereof with the appurtenances unto the James Wood
