

404 The following Lease and Release from Thomas Wood to
 Bartholomew Wood being proven before Sam^l. Cass Esq^r. by
 the oath of Dan^l. Kelly was recorded this 21st Dec^r. 1793
 This Indenture made this fifteenth day of June in
 the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & eighty
 seven Between Thomas Wood of the State of North Carolina
 in Greeneville County of the one part and Bartholomew
 Wood Junr. of the same state & County aforesaid of the other
 part Witnesseth that the said Thomas Wood for use in consi-
 deration of five Shillings Sterling Money to him in hand paid
 at or before the sealing and delivering of these presents the Receipt
 whereof is thereby acknowledged hath granted bargain sold
 and by these presents doth grant bargain sell unto the said
 Bar^{tholomew} Wood Junr. all that plantation and Tract of Land on both sides
 Middle fork Saluda River containing one hundred fifty acres
 bounded as followeth Viz, the first line extending S. E. 33
 bounded on John Brandon Tract No^l 58 on the said land
 No^l 58 Variant No^l 38 to the Beginning line together
 with all and singular the houses buildings woods waters water
 courses profits commodities emoluments & accoutrements
 whatsoever to the said plantation or tract of land containing
 150 acres aforesaid more or less within the lines above men-
 tioned or in any wise appertaining or which are or have been
 heretofore accepted reputed taken known held occupied or enjoyed
