to William Towns being proven before Larkin Tarrant  
Esq. by the oath of In. Mactoth was Recorded this 3<sup>rd</sup> June 1794

and ninety four between John Hunt of the State of South  
Carolina and Greenville County of the one part & William  
Towns of the said State & County aforesaid of the other part

Towns at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents
