This Indenture made this fifth day of May in the year of  
 our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety four and in  
 the eighteenth year of American Independance between Lem-  
 uel J. Alston of the State of Carolina District of Washington  
 and County of Greenville of the one part and Isaac Green of  
 the same State District & County aforesaid of the other part  
 Witnesseth that the said Lemuel J. Alston for himself his heirs  
 Exors<sup>s</sup> Adm<sup>rs</sup> and assigns hath bargained sold and conveyed  
 unto the said Isaac Green his heirs Exors<sup>s</sup> Adm<sup>rs</sup> and assigns  
 for ever for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty pounds  
 Sterling Money a certain tract or parcel of land lying situate  
 in the County of Greenville district & State before mentioned
