456 The following deed of conveyance from John Stanford to
Joseph Callaway being, proven before Reuben Barrett Esq^r by
the oath of Leonard Clayburn was Recorded this 9th June 1794
This Indenture made the sixteenth day of August in
the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred ninety
three between John Stanford Jun^r of Greenville County
in the State of South Carolina of the one part and Joseph
Callaway of the County & State aforesaid of the other part
Witnesseth that the said John Stanford Jun^r for and in con-
sideration of the sum of thirty five pounds Sterling Money
to him in hand well and truly paid by the said Joseph Cal-
laway, the receipt whereof the said John Stanford Jun^r doth
hereby acknowledge, and for which the said John Stanford
hath granted bargained sold aliened, released conveyed and
confirmed, and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien
release convey and confirm unto the said Joseph Callaway
his heirs and assigns all that plantation tract or parcel of
land containing one hundred & Twelve acres more or less in
his actual possession now being and including the plan-
tation on which the said Joseph Callaway now lives
lying and being in the County & State aforesaid on the
