James Deek being proven before In^o Thomas Esq^r by the
Oath of In^o McHaffey and Recorded this 10th day June 1794
This Indenture made the seventh day of February
one thousand seven hundred and ninety four and in the
Eighteenth year of American Independence between John Deek
Blacksmith of the State of South Carolina and Greenville
County planter of the one part, and James Deek Gun Worker
of the State County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth
that the said John Deek for and in consideration of the sum
of one hundred and Twenty pounds Sterling in hand paid
by the said James Deek, the Receipt of which is hereby ac-
knowledged, he the said John Deek hath bargained sold
and by these presents doth bargain and sell all that plan-
tation or Tract of two hundred acres of land lying and
being in the State aforesaid and District of ninety six
lying on the middle fork of Connerss Creek, the waters of
Bluce River, the same being Granted to Joseph Walker by a
Grant bearing date the twenty first day of January one
thousand seven hundred & Eighty five in the Secretaries
office in Book BBBB page 118 Reference therunto will
more fully appear Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the
said John Deek for the Consideration one hundred & Twenty
pounds Sterling hath ^{bargained} granted and sold Remised, released
conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth give
