This Indenture made the sixteenth day of Decem-
ber in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred
and ninety three and in the eighteenth year of the
Independence of the united States of America between
William Smith Stevens of Charleston in the state aforesaid
and Elizabeth his wife of the one part and William
Griffin Turner of Greenville County Washington District
and State aforesaid planter of the other part Witnesseth that
for and in consideration of the sum of eighty pounds
Sterling to him the said William Smith Stevens & Elizabeth
his wife or one of them in hand at and before the sealing
and delivery of these presents by the said William Griffin
Turner well and Truly paid, the receipt whereof the said
William Smith Stevens doth hereby acknowledge and
thereof and every part and parcel thereof doth acquit re-
lease exonerate and discharge the said William Griffin
Turner his heirs Executors and Administrators and every
of them for ever by these presents they the said William
Smith Stevens and Elizabeth his wife have granted bar-
gained sold aliened released and confirmed and by these
presents do fully freely clearly and absolutely, Grant bar-
gain sell alien release and confirm unto the said William
Griffin Turner in their actual possession now being by
virtue of a bargain and sale to him thereof made by the
said William Smith Stevens for one whole year for the
consideration of five Shillings by an Indenture of lease bear-
ing date the day next before the day of the date of these
presents to commence the day next before the day of the
date hereof and sealed and delivered before the executing
of these presents, and also by force of the Statute for Trans-
ferring of uses into possession in that case made and pro-
vided and to his heirs and assigns for ever all that plan-
tation or tract of land containing three hundred acres sit-
uate on Saluda River (above the Antient boundary line)
bounding South west on said River, all other sides on vacant
land. Together with all and singular the Gardens Orchards
