

oath of John Davis was Recorded this 2nd day of Jan^y 1795
State of South Carolina This Indenture made the
fifth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand
seven hundred Ninety two between Joseph Reed of the
County of Greenville & State aforesaid of the one part
& Caleb Carp of the County & State aforesaid of the other
part Witnesseth that the said Joseph Reed for & in con-
sideration of the sum of Twenty five pounds to him in
hand paid by the said Caleb Carp at & before the sealing
& delivering of these presents the Receipt of which the
said Joseph Reed doth acknowledge & thereof & of & from
every part and parcel thereof doth acquit & discharge the
said Caleb Carp his heirs & assigns & for divers other good
causes and considerations hereunto moving have
granted bargained sold aliened Enfeoffed & confirmed
and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien confirm
