548 The following Deed of Conveyance from Albert Francis
Smithson to William Trammell being proven before
George Salmon Esq. by the oath of David Norris was
presented and recorded this 17th day of January 1795
This Indenture made this fifth day of April in the
year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & Ninety
four and in the eighteenth year of the Independence
of the united States of America Between Albert Smithson of
the County of Greenville Washington District of the one
part & William Trammell of the County aforesaid of the
other part Witnesseth that the said Albert Smithson for & in
consideration of the sum of fifty pounds Sterling to him
in hand paid by the said William Trammell before the
sealing & delivering of these presents the receipt whereof
the said Albert Smithson doth hereby acknowledge and
therefore doth release acquit and discharge the said
William Trammell his heirs Executors & Assigns by these presents
doth grant bargain sell alien convey & confirm unto the
said William Trammell & his heirs a certain tract or parcel of
land situate in the County of Greenville & District of
Washington District on a branch of Bridge Creek of Saluda
Beginning at a sower wood corner made on Albert Smith-
son line & laid out by parties consent it being part of a
four thousand one tract of land Granted to Robert Prince
it being by estimation one hundred & fifty acres more or
less it being the land that that the said Marson Smithson
bought of Robert Prince and laid out by consent of parties
and taken from the four thousand one tract Granted to Rob-
ert Prince the seventh day of March one thousand seven
hundred and Eighty seven and under the hand of his
Excellency Tho. Pinckney Esq. & the great seal of the State
