Benjamin Barton hath granted bargained & sold and by these presents doth grant bargain & set to George Brazel his heirs & assigns that plantation or tract of land containing sixty five acres be the same more or less beginning on a poplar from thence N 60th 18 chain to a pile of Rocks thence N 50 6 1/2 chain fifty links to a red oak thence S 65 E 15 chain & 50 links to a Locust thence S 53th 11 1/2 chain & 30 links to a spanish Oak thence S 5th 6 chain & 50 links to the beginning together with all singular the woods waters profits commodities hereditaments & appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining to have & to hold the said tract of land hereby granted & sold with their & every & every of their appurtenances unto the S. George Brazel his heirs and assigns for ever & the said Benjamin Barton for himself his heirs & assigns the said bargained premises with their appurtenances unto the S. George Brazel his heirs & assigns against the Claim or claims of the S. Benjamin Barton his heirs & all other persons in & under him laying any just right or claim thereto shall & will warrant & for ever defend by these presents In Witness whereof the S. Benjamin Barton hath set his hand and seal the day and year first above written.

8 The following Deed of Conveyance from Septha Cornelias to William Cornelias being proven before John Ford Esq. by the oath of Edward Stringer was presented and Recorded this 10th day of January 1795 This Indenture made this thirteenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety four between Septha Cornelias on the one part, & William Cornelias on the other both of the State of South Carolina and Greenville County Witnesseth that the said Septha Cornelias for and in consideration of fifty pounds Sterling to him in hand paid at or before the sealing & delivering of these presents the receipt & payment whereof is hereby fully acknowledged, hath given granted & sold by these presents, doth give grant bargain & sell alien & release convey & confirm unto the S. William Cornelias his heirs and assigns for ever a certain piece or tract of land situate lying & being in the State & County aforesaid on the North fork of Saluda River butting & bounding as follows Viz beginning on a wild Cherry tree being the Corner of the afo. William Cornelias's land and running thence with the said line S 65 E 16 C 10 l to a Mahogany thence S 15th. to a stake in the S. line being the beginning of a dividing line agreed on between Denis Duff a former owner of S. land & the S. Septha Cornelias, running thence by a red oak to where the Beaver dam Branch empties into the River, & up the main Course of the S. branch to a Mulberry tree continuing the aforesaid Course by a large poplar to the wt line thence to the beginning containing by estimation thirty acres be the
