 sold & by these presents doth grant bargain & sell unto him the S^r John Heddl-
 ston his heirs & assigns a certain part of the S^r tract of land containing one
 hundred & fifty acres more or less beginning on a Chesnut corner agreed on &
 made by the S^r Maxwell & Heddlston standing on an old line that was run
 for James Maxwell & running thence South 40 degrees East to a pine & thence
 South 40 west 10 ch^s 30 links to a stake on Samuel Casley's land thence South
 20 west 45 chains to a post oak & thence crossing the S^r tract of land to a pine &
 on land belonging to David Hall, thence N 10 west 11 chain 50 to a pine & thence
 North 60 west 7 chains to a Chesnut oak & thence North 10 west 19 chains
 crossing parolale river to a red oak & thence North 60 E 13 chains to a white
 oak & thence North 30 west 12 chains to a lower wood & thence North E 2 1/2
 11 chains to a stake & on an agreed line made the S^r parties thence North
 60 East to the beginning fall trees woods under woods & this commons & common
 of pasture ways water courses profits commodities advantages hereditaments
 appurtenances whatsoever to the S^r piece of land above mentioned belonging or

The following Deed of Conveyance from John Thomas Jun^r to Thomas
 & David Moore being proven before Reuben Barrett Esq^r by the oath of
 Robert Carter was presented & Recorded this 17th day of January 1795
 This Indenture made the tenth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand
 seven hundred & ninety four between John Thomas Jun^r of Granville County
 State of South Carolina of the one part, & Thomas & David Moore sons & heirs
 of David Moore deceased of the other part witnesseth that the S^r John Tho-
 mas Jun^r for in consideration of the sum of Twenty four pounds lawful
 money of the state afores^d to him in hand well & truly paid by the S^r Tho-
 mas & David Moore before the sealing & delivery hereof the receipt is hereby
 acknowledged the S^r John Thomas Jun^r hath granted bargained sold alien-
 ed released conveyed & confirmed & by these presents doth grant bargain sell
 alien release convey & confirm unto the S^r Thomas & David Moore their heirs
