

The following deed of Conveyance from William Clayton to William White being proven before Reuben Barnett Esq^r by the Oath of Robert Smith was presented & recorded this 29th day of March AD 1795

This Indenture made this twenty first day of January
and in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & Ninety five
between William Clayton of Greenville County & State of South Carolina
of the one part & William White of the County & State aforesaid of the other
part witnesseth that he the said William Clayton for & in consideration
of six pounds Sterling to him in hand paid on or before the sealing &
delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby fully acknow-
ledged hath for himself his heirs Exec^r Adm^r & assigns granted bargain-
ed & sold aliened released & confirmed by these presents doth grant bar-
gain sell alien release confirm & convey unto the said William White his
his heirs Exec^r Adm^r & assigns for ever all that tract of land situate lying
& being on the waters north side of South Pacalate River & in the County
Greenville & the aforesaid having such marks & shapes as follow: begining
on a large white oak on south side of a branch running through Allen
Gowens field it being a conational corner from its south side said
branch to small white oak, then to post oak, then loaping near the head
& south said branch, thence to a chestnut & on thence thither along
said line to a chestnut & from thence along said line to red oak & there
cornered then ~~th~~ a conditional line from thre to chestnut, then to black
oak, then to black oak, then to chestnut oak, then to white oak, then to black
oak & on Sam^e Easleys line, then along said line to Allen Goins, then
along said line to the begining corner it being apart of that tract of land grant-
ed to William Clayton the said tract of land containing one hundred acres

to William Clayton his heirs of in & to the premises aforesaid & in
and to every part thereof to have and to hold the said tract or parcel
of land containing one hundred more or less & premises with all and
singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertain-
ing to him the said William White his heirs Exec^r Adm^r & assigns to the
only proper use & behoof of said William White his heirs & assigns for
ever free & clear & from all incumbrance whatsoever the quit rents or
services to grow due or payable for & in respect of the premises only
excepted, and he the said William Clayton his heirs Exec^r Adm^r & assigns
doth hereby Covenant grant & agree to & with the said William White
his heirs & assigns by these presents that the said Will. Clayton his
heirs & assigns to the said tract of land containing one hundred acres
