Adm. & assigns from the day of the date hereof for & during twenty the full end & term of one whole year from thence next ensuing and fully to be completed and ended yielding & paying thereupon unto the said James King & Margaret King his wife at the expiration of the said term the rent of one peper corn if lawfully demanded to the intent that by virtue of these presents and by force of the Statute for Transferring uses into possession the said Henry Paris may be in the actual possession of the premises and thereby enabled to accept and take a grant and release of the reversion and inheritance hereof to him and his heirs for ever In witness whereof the said parties to these presents their hands & seals have been unto Interchangeably set on the day and in the year first above mentioned the word David Mc Kinney sealed out and the name Henry Paris Interlined before sealing & delivering James King —

Witnesseth That the said James King & Margaret King his wife in consideration of fifty four pounds Sterling Money of the said State to him paid James King & King his wife now in hand paid by the said Henry Paris aforesaid granted bargain & sold alien released and confirmed these presents do grant bargain & sell alien release and confirm the said Henry Paris in his actual possession now being by virtue of a grant to sale to him thereof made by Indenture bearing date the twelveth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and two hundred and six years on branches of land bounded where
