12 The following Deed of Conveyance from Allin Gowen to William  
 Easley being proven before Reuben Barrett Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of William  
 Anderson was presented and Recorded this 28<sup>th</sup> April 1795  
 This Indenture made this first day of October in the year of our  
 Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety four and in the  
 nineteenth year of the Independency of America between Allin  
 Gowen of the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina  
 of the one part and William Easley of the County & State afores<sup>d</sup>  
 of the other part, whereas in a certain Grant bearing date the  
 twenty first day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand  
 seven hundred and eighty six from under the hand of his Excellency  
 Benjamin Gerard Esq<sup>r</sup> Governor & Commander in Chief the State  
 of South Carolina for that purpose appointed did give and grant unto  
 Samuel Easley a certain tract or parcel of land containing three  
 hundred & fifty three acres by the same more or less situated lying  
 and being on both sides of South Pacotah River and hath such shape  
 form and Marks as appears by aplat to the said Grant annexed the  
 said plat and grant being duly Recorded in the Secretaries Office  
 the said tract of land includes the plantations where Samuel Easley  
 and Allin Gowen now live witnesseth that the said Allin Gowen for  
 the consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty pounds  
 Sterling Money to him in hand paid by the said William Easley the  
 receipt he has hereby acknowledged he the said Allin Gowen hath  
 granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bar-  
 gain & sell unto the said William Easley his heirs and assigns a plat:
