The following deed of Conveyance from Samuel Snoddy to John Braswell being proven before Reuben Parrell Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of Bright Druwell was presented and recorded this 9<sup>th</sup> June A<sup>d</sup> 1795

This Indenture made this 5 day of December the year of our Lord one thousand one thousand seven hundred and ninety one between Samuel Snoddy of the one part, & John Braswell of the other part both of the State of South Carolina and Greenville County witnesseth, that the said Samuel Snoddy for and in consideration of the sum of Ten pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by said John Braswell the receipt and payment whereof is hereby fully acknowledged hath given granted and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell alien and release convey & transform unto the said John Braswell his heirs and assigns for ever a certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the State & County aforesaid on the sink hole fork of Lygar river joining land with said Bright Druwell it being a the upper end of a tract of land granted to Samuel Snoddy the fifth day of August one thousand seven hundred & eighty five and all that part of said tract that lyeth north & east of a tract of land the said Druwell now lies on that was granted to William Lynch Together with all woods ways waters and water courses buildings Improvements and appurtenances whatsoever unto the same belonging or in any wise respecting or appertaining with the rents Issues & profits thereof unto the said John Braswell his heirs and assigns for ever free and clear from all Incumbrance whatsoever peaceably & quietly to possess and enjoy the same to have and to hold the above described tract or parcel of land unto the only proper use be and behoof of him the said John Braswell his heirs and assigns for ever and the said Samuel Snoddy his heirs Ex<sup>ors</sup> or Adm<sup>ors</sup>. The said tract or parcel of land above described and appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the said John Braswell his heirs and assigns against all and every person or persons lawfully claiming the said premises or any part thereof shall and will warrant and as well in equity as in Law by these presents for ever defend In witness whereof the said Samuel Snoddy hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year first above written
