 proven before John Blasingame by the oath of Patrick Lafferty was
 presented and recorded this 17th day of June A.D. 1795

This Indenture made this twenty fourth day of April in the year of
 our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety five between James
 Hide of Greenville County and State of South Carolina of the part & David
 Weeks of the said State and County of the other part Witnesseth that the s^r
 James Hide for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five pounds
 Sterling money to him in hand well and Truly paid by the s^r David
 Weeks at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the
 receipt hereof the said James Hide doth hereby acknowledge and
 thereof and of and from every part and parcel thereof do acquit
 and discharge the said David Weeks his heirs and assigns and for
 divers other good causes and considerations hereunto moving
 have granted bargained sold aliened aliened conveyed & confirmed
 unto the said David Weeks his heirs and assigns for ever all that por-
 cel or Tract of land lying and being in Greenville County on both
 sides of the Road of the branch the waters of needy river containing fifty
 acres more or less begining at a post oak x on Laffertys line, from thence
 to a pine x from thence to a post oak on Jacob Black x along the s^r line
 to a stake x from thence to Swets line & along Swets line to a white oak
 on the branch x up the branch, the branch being the line to a post oak x
 from thence to the begining corner it being a part of a Tract of land contain-
 ing two hundred acres Originally granted unto John Lafferty & signed by
 his Excellency Thomas Pinckney on the sixt day of October one thousand
 seven hundred and eighty eight as by a plat annexed to the same grant
 will more fully appear Together with all and singular the Houses out
