This Indenture made the ninth day of March in the year
 of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six and in
 the nineteenth year of the Sovereignty and Independance of the
 United States of America Between Thomas Farrar of the County of
 Pennington in the district of Washington in the State of South Carolina
 Esquire and high Sheriff of the aforesaid district of Washington of the
 one part, and Charles Goodwin of the Village of Cambridge in the
 County of Abbeville and district of Ninety six in the said State Esquire
 Advocate and Counsellor of Law, and William Nibbs of the Village
 of Cambridge aforesaid Esquire of the other part Witnesseth that
 the said Thomas Farrar in consideration of five shillings lawful
 Money of South Carolina to him in hand paid by the said Charles
 Goodwin and William Nibbs at or before the sealing and delivery
 of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) &
 for other good Causes and Valuable considerations the said Thomas
 Farrar hereunto Moving hath bargained and sold and by these
 presents doth bargain & sell unto the said Charles Goodwin & Will-
 iam Nibbs their Executors Administrators and assigns all those
 Twenty Several plantations tracts or parcels of land adjoining and
 contiguous to one another and containing each one thousand
 statute acres, and in the whole Twenty thousand acres like measure
 situate lying and being on the North and Middle fork of the River
 Saluda in the County of Greenville and District of Washington aforesaid
 and which said plantations or parcels of land have Individually
